3. SC Champs 2023, GLZ Meet, Y Nats

Jon/Mike

Jon: summary of own meets – teams set up their own meets. League runs A champs and AA champs. After AA champs, the next meets (not hosted by league) are GLZ and Y Nats.

A meet: Runs at 3 sites (North, Central, South for prelims and then teams from Central have divided in the past for finals to go to north or south. This year, the league is proposing to have the 3 sites to host their own finals at the same location.

- Proposal is 3 sites again for finals for 11 & O. 10 & U are timed finals. Relays
 are timed finals. Having 3 sites will allow results to process faster than in the
 past so athletes know who is qualified for finals. Awards are based on the sites
 as well. Meet packets will be site specific depending on the # of lanes. # of
 heats per site will be dependent upon on the site. There will most likely be an A
 and B final. The number of heats will be announced in each sites' meet packet.
- Question about finals heats: Will there be 2 heats, will there be top 16 across
 the board or will the south site include top 20 because PCY has 10 lanes vs CY
 and Trotwood having 8 lanes. Can you add language in the meet packet that
 says the # of finals swimmers will depend on the number of entries (e.g. 400
 IMs may have less than the total # of lanes.)
- Motion: Matt R formatted. Deanna seconded. Vote: All voted to have 3 finals sites and motion carries.

AA Champs: The league runs AA Champs and each team is asked to help out with providing some of the volunteer positions/tasks. Stipend is provided to the team that does help out/volunteer.

GLZ: The host team has lost coaches, swimmers, etc. and the host team has asked the SWOYSL to help pull the Zone committee back together (Contacted Bill W and he's still helping). Dave Stannert with Ft. Meigs may be new GLZ chair. Mike L has asked to see the contract from the current host team to review what's been agreed upon to date with SPIRE Institute.
