LC Champs 2023 was more crowded with more attendees/athlete than AAs 2023. A proposed order of events for LC Champs 2024 were handed out to all teams at the meeting. The proposal is to allow as many events as possible be swum by as many athletes as possible. (There are a lot of events and we're trying to avoid holding a 4-day or 5-day "jam" packed weekend.)

- Thursday session: proposed 400 free and 200 IM. 3-hour session
- Friday morning: 11 & overs starting at 8:30 and finishing around 12pm. Proposing all 11-12 events are timed finals rather than prelims/finals.
- Friday afternoon: 800 Free to start around 1pm and finish around 2:10
- Friday finals: 13 & O
- Saturday & Sunday prelims: 13 & O start around 8:30 and end around 11:45 with 11-12s moving to afternoon session of timed finals.
- Saturday & Sunday afternoon sessions end around 5:45 with finals ending around 8:30-9 pm
- Mile does have top heat included in finals
- Biggest changes are 11-12s being timed finals. Some relays being dropped may not be as big of a change but the athletes haven't been swimming as well on these relays. We're attempting to save time and keep as many individual events as possible.
- Motion to accept basic format as presented with changes: ABLY motioned, SPY & BASH 2nd.
 - Discussion: if 12-year-olds swim 200 strokes, there's a chance the swimmer may swim Senior events in morning for stroke events and then swim 11-12 session in afternoon with possibility to qualify for 200 Stroke events in Finals at night. Coaches will need to decide what events and consider all options. Not sure if league should get involved in this decision since it should be up to coaches.
 - o All in favor, no opposed. Motion carries
- LC time standards will come in the Spring 2024 as well as information about how to order champs shirts.

5. Ohio Swimming and YMCA meets in SWIMS

Ohio Swimming will now only allow Y meets to count in SWIMS database once they get the Y sanction when you apply for approval. Meet needs to be sanctioned 60 days prior to event through Team Unify and this is now for invitationals. Information was sent out from Y National. (YMCA sanction can be done on Team Unify where you add your coaches. Fill out information then send them the meet packet. Once it's approved then you can send it to Ohio Swimming for their approval.)

It's not required to have a sanction to run a meet; the only reason for the sanction is if you want to submit and include times in SWIMS database for USA Swimming.
